This is to certify that I have this day Mustered-in-to the United States Service, FOR ~~WAR~~ *War*, John Hays as 2d Lieutenant and Mustering Officer for Captain Wm M Porter + Company ( + ) + Regiment of Pennsylvania Volunteers, as per appointment of Governor Curtin, (State of Pennsylvania,) and in conformity with the 1st paragraph of General Orders No. 75, dated War Department, A. G. O., Washington, D. C., July 8th, 1862.
