BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Brockey, who later was known as Charles Walter Buck, was a Blackfeet Piegan born on January 21, 1876. He attended the Carlisle Indian School from March 26, 1890 until June 3, 1895, and while there was sent on outing four times. After leaving Carlisle, Brockey married another Carlisle student, Spyna Devereaux (also Blackfeet Piegan), and was involved in stock-raising in Montana. After his first wife Spyna died on February 5, 1929 Brockey married Florence McKenzie in 1930. Brockey died in the Columbus Hospital in Great Falls, Montana on December 12, 1932.

COLLECTION DESCRIPTION

The Brockey (Charles Walter Buck) Collection is housed in one document box. These materials were donated by Tom Anderson, whose late wife Patricia was the great niece of Florence McKenzie. The collection has been organized into two categories: Newspaper Clippings and Photographs.

The Newspaper Clippings section includes a transcript of an obituary for Brockey using his name Charles Walter Buck, and a full-page feature about the 2000 "Remembering Carlisle Indian School" Powwow.

The Photograph section includes 11 images believed to be owned by Brockey and Spyna Devereaux. All of these images date from the 1890s, when they attended the Carlisle Indian School. They are arranged by physical size.

The Oversized Newspaper section includes a full issue of Volume 2, Number 35 of the *Glacier County Chief*, which includes the original obituary for Brockey using his name Charles Walter Buck. That obituary is located on the rightmost two columns of page 1 and the fourth column from the left on page 4.
