☞ Ranaway from the subscriber, living near Jefferson, Frederick County, Md., on *Saturday the 22nd of September inst.*, **TWO NEGRO MEN**, one a bright Mulatto Man, a little near sighted, and is about **5 feet 9 or 10 inches**, and calls himself *Bill Dorsey*.

The other is a very black negro man, about **5 feet 7 or 8 inches high** and calls himself *John Ceders*, has thick lips and lisps a little when he talks.
