Dear Sir

In the enclosed Letter to Mr Shippin is a List of Actions that I expect to try at the next Courts of Pleas in the Counties of Cumberland York and Northumberland. The Sheriff informs me that he has sent you Lists to be filed with the Venues, ^{in Court. Oppositely} I doubt not but the Lists are composed of good Men; and if any of them should happen to be too much connected with the Parties in any of the Causes; or if any other reasonable Objection should appear against them; I hope the Council on the opposite Side will be candid and good natured enough to consent to the proper Alterations. — I presume you will be in Philadelphia at the Supreme Court; and will give you the Trouble to see that my Actions be put in a proper Situation for Trial. The Bearer of this Letter will wait till you make out the Lists for Mr Shippin; if you think proper to send them by him. Please to seal Mr Shippin's Letter.

I have the Pleasure to inform you that my Family has, a Week ago, received the Addition of a young Son. Mrs Wilson is in a very fair Way. Her Compliments and mine wait on Mr Gates and you. I am
