
Dear Red,

I am sending over to you the solid gold Glover medallion which was made by the Royal Mint and which my brother, John Yeagley, presented to the college. In addition I am sending you eighteen (18) copies of the very fine gold plated replicas which will be used for presentation to the Glover Lecturers as the years go by. Already we have given one of these fine replicas to Dr. van de Kamp and I will be responsible for getting one ready for Dr. Walton of England and one for Dr. Livingston of Harvard who were the first two Glover lecturers. We need to have the names of the Glover lecturers engraved around the edge in the space now occupied by Mr. Glover's name and the date of the original presentations.

Since we were unable to get a suitable case to present Dr. van de Kamp's, we presented it to him in the box that the original solid gold one came in. This leaves us with the problem of getting a new velvet lined box for the original and then to get boxes for the ones that will be given in the future. I will also assume this responsibility if you wish me to.

I would appreciate it if you will notify the Physics Department as to where these replica medallions will be stored so that each year it will be readily possible to get out the one for the current presentation. Also, I believe some arrangements should be made to put the original solid gold one on display after we have been able to get a suitable velvet lined box for it.
