BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Naomi (Negahuegesheqoqua) Greensky, Chippewa, was a student at the Carlisle Indian Industrial School from 1903 to 1911. She was then readmitted to the school in 1912 and graduated in 1915. Her brother, John Greensky, attended the school from 1903 to 1908, and her other brother, Peter Greensky, attended the school from 1911 to 1914. Simon Greensky, father of Naomi, John, and Peter, was a Methodist pastor in Oscoda, Michigan. One of the Carlisle Indian School's defining features was its outing system in which students were sent to work for and live with a white family – something Naomi Greensky did numerous times. Additionally, Naomi was a member of the Mercer Literary Society at the school. From this collection, it is unclear what Naomi Greensky did after she graduated from the Carlisle Indian School.

COLLECTION DESCRIPTION

The Naomi Greensky Collection is housed in one letter-sized archival box. These materials were acquired through eBay in 2018. The collection has been organized into two sections, Papers and Photographs. Most of the Papers can be categorized as ephemera and reflect extracurricular activities that Naomi participated in while at Carlisle. The papers include dance cards, holiday cards, a commencement program, and materials from Mercer Literary Society. There are also several calling cards or business cards from the Great Northern Railway and Glacier National Park. The Photographs include several postage-stamp sized images taken and developed at Carlisle Indian School's Leupp Art Studio. The individuals pictured in the photographs are suspected to be students from the school, but most are unidentified. One young woman appears in six photographs – four as a young adult and two as a child – suggesting that she may be Naomi. A young man appears in three of the photographs, and it is likely that this young man is Naomi's brother, Peter Greensky.
