#### HISTORICAL NOTE

The Dickinson College Student Senate was authorized in April, 1908 as a men's student run organization that, in many respects was to be the voice of the student community on campus. Early on in its existence, the Senate was a male only organization, before it became integrated with both men and women in 1936.

Among other things, the Senate is responsible for approving and funding campus clubs, resolving issues, and governing the student body of Dickinson College. Moreover, through the use of numerous committees, the Senate has been, and is, able to effectively provide for the needs of the students. Its most important function however, is ultimately being the representative of the students to the faculty, administration, and to the outside community.

This series is divided into two sub-series that relate to the initial authorization by the Dickinson College faculty to allow a student assembly and the constitutions of the Senate. The first sub-series deals with the 1908 creation of men's Student Assembly. There are guidelines established that both the assembly and the faculty agreed upon, the majority of which are laid out in correspondence. The second sub-series pertains to the rules governing how the Senate has run up until the present day. The constitutions and bylaws range in time from 1919 to 1997.

#### SERIES 5 FINANCIAL OPERATIONS DESCRIPTION

This series relating to financial operations is divided into two sub-series, financial operations and budget requests. The financial operations series is arranged chronologically and contains papers and correspondence relating to the decisions made by the Student Senate Finance Committee. These decisions include the granting and repayment of loans to various student groups as well as the routine handling of each group's Student Senate account.

Budget requests were made by organizations seeking monies from the Student Senate to finance specific events and the regular upkeep of the organization. Each requesting organization must have their request broken down into line items, have it in writing, and present and defend the request to the Senate's Finance Committee. Each folder represents requests for the school year indicated. All requests for a specific school year were held in the spring of the previous school year. In addition, clubs, sports teams, and organizations were allowed to request additional funs in the Fall semester.

The folders in this series are laid out as follows: any Finance Committee rules and regulations for the year, requests in alphabetical order by organization requesting, and finally the Finance Committee's proposed budget to the Senate. The proposed yearly budget is first, followed by the Fall's additional request budget. In some folders, the Finance Committee also attached a response sheet indicating to the requesting organization what was approved, what was not, and why. Also, most requests that have duplicates were included because of the handwritten notes taken by Finance Committee members during the time of the specific club's appointment to defend their budget request.

This daily publication covered Student Senate news, sports, social events and club meetings, and announced upcoming events to the student body. From 1958 it was called *The Daily Senator* and continued with this name through 1966. During the Spring Semester 1966, the frequency of *The Daily Senator* was cut to twice a week. For the Fall Semester 1966, "Daily" was dropped from the publications' name, becoming *The Senator*. The second sub-series contains issues of *The Senator*, published between 1966 and 1974. Between 1974 and 1983 another name change occurred. The third sub-series consists of issues of the *Senator II* from 1983-84. A second Student Senate newsletter, *A Change of Pace*, comprises the fourth sub-series - a single issue dated November 1988.
