**BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE**

Karl Tinsley Waugh was born on November 30, 1879 in Cawnpore, India to missionaries James Walter Waugh and Jennie M. Tinsley Waugh, the youngest of seven children. Karl grew up and attended school in India until high school, when the family moved to Massachusetts. He earned both his A.B. and M.A. from Ohio Wesleyan University, and his A.M and Ph. D from Harvard University. Much of Waugh's work was in psychology, undertaking research as a student, a professor, and a government researcher.

After completing his education, Waugh served as a professor and administrator for several academic institutions including Claflin University (1900-1904), Harvard University (1905-1907), the University of Chicago (1907-1909), the University of Colorado (1909), Beloit College (1909-1917), Berea College (1919-1923), Northwestern University (1921), the University of Southern California (1923-1931), Long Island University (1931-1932), and Dickinson College. He served as President of Dickinson College from May of 1932 to June of 1933. A great deal of controversy surrounded his resignation as president from the college. Waugh claimed that he was forced to leave the college by supporters of James Henry Morgan, his predecessor, on untrue charges made public in a letter published in the Carlisle *Sentinel*. Following his departure from Dickinson, Waugh served as dean of the Charles Morris Prince School of Advertising and Journalism in the Philadelphia Area.

Outside of academia, Karl served on a psychological investigation in China from 1916 to 1917. In the two following years, he served the army and the Surgeon General as a psychological examiner at Camp Gordon, Camp McClellan, and Fort McPherson. After leaving higher education, Waugh served as a deputy director for the Pennsylvania Department of Public Assistance and as a chief guidance counselor for Veterans Affairs until his retirement in 1953. Karl Waugh died in 1971 at the age of 91, survived by his wife Emily Sprightley Waugh and his children Eleanor Tinsley Waugh and Charles McCarthy Waugh.

## COLLECTION DESCRIPTION

The Karl Tinsley Waugh collection consists of three boxes of personal papers, 56 folders of photographs, one oversized folder, and one artifact box. The personal papers are divided into five series: Correspondence, Financial Records, Photo Albums, Scholastic Materials, and Miscellaneous Materials. The photographs are divided into seven series: People - Individuals, People - Family Groups, People - Other Groups, People - Unknown, India, Eurasia and Africa, and United States of America. The collection reflects the personal lives of Karl Tinsley Waugh as well as his father, wife, and children.

The Correspondence series contains letters to various members of the Waugh family and is arranged into four subseries: Charles Waugh, Emily Waugh, Karl Waugh, and Waugh Family. These letters are generally arranged alphabetically, although in some cases all correspondence surrounding a particular topic or from a particular sender are grouped together. These papers document mostly personal business, especially the philatelic interests of Charles Waugh and the fraternal and academic activities of Karl Waugh. The final subseries contains correspondence addressed to multiple members of the Waugh family.

The Financial Records series contains information on various stocks held by the Waugh family, and is arranged by corporation. All of these records relate to the investing activities of Karl Waugh, with the exception of the materials from the Associated Oil Company, which relate to the finances of Karl's father, James Walter Waugh.

The Photo Albums series contains three albums, two from James Walter Waugh's missionary activities in India, and one from Karl Waugh's young adult life. Two of the albums are disbound. Loose photographs and papers inserted throughout these albums were relocated to the Photograph and Miscellaneous Materials series.

The Scholastic Materials series includes the academic papers and ephemera of Charles, Emily, and Karl Waugh. These include materials from Charles's studies at Carlisle Junior and Senior High School, as well as the academic research and creative writings of Karl Waugh.

The Miscellaneous Materials series includes personal papers and ephemera related to Emily Waugh, James Walter Waugh, and Karl Waugh, as well as the Tinsley and Waugh families. Included in this series are notes and drafts of Karl Waugh's inaugural address, and materials from James Walter Waugh's work as a missionary in India and his involvement with the Evangelical Methodist church.

The Photographs collection includes both photographic prints and negatives, which are interfiled. Some prints do not have corresponding negatives, and some negatives do not have corresponding prints. These photographs come from the collections of both James Walter Waugh and Karl Waugh. James Walter Waugh's images relate to his missionary work in India, especially in the Nainital and Calcutta regions, where he established both schools and churches. Karl Waugh's photographs focus on his family life and personal activities.

The People-Individuals series includes images of individual people, mostly members of Waugh's extended family. The People-Family Groups series similarly contains shots of groups of Waugh's extended family members. The People-Other Groups series includes images of various groups, which may or may not include Waugh or a member of his family. The People-Unknown series is arranged by descriptive information, when available.

The India series of photographs originate from the materials of James Walter Waugh, and are dated circa 1880. The series is broken down into subseries based on the subject of the photographs. The Eurasia and Africa series includes photographs from the travels of both James Walter Waugh and Karl Waugh, but are largely unidentified. The United States of America

subseries includes images of Karl Waugh's various homes. Accurate descriptions, including both original and modernized spellings, are included in this finding aid.

The Oversized folder contains a large matted photograph of the flower girls from the wedding of Karl Waugh and Emily Sprightley.

The Artifact box contains a Photette with a photograph of an unidentified man. Photettes were souvenirs made by enclosing a photograph in a circular metal disc for greater durability and aesthetic appeal.

Several items relating to Emily Waugh's work with Churchill Weavers were transferred to Berea College in Berea, Kentucky. Several items relating to Karl Tinsley Waugh's work as editor of various creative writing magazines in southern California were transferred to the University of Southern California in Los Angeles.
