BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Virginia Irene Meyers was born on May 13, 1910 in Hollidaysburg, Pennsylvania. The daughter of Eli Meyers and Emma Irene Clapper, Virginia was the oldest of three daughters. She received her high school diploma from Hollidaysburg High School in the spring of 1928.

Virginia entered Dickinson College on September 20, 1928 pursuant of her teaching certification. While attending Dickinson, Virginia was involved with the Harman Literary Society as well as the French Club. She graduated in the spring of 1932.

It appears that Virginia taught for a few years after graduation. Later, she took a position as a social worker for the Red Cross. She stayed with the Red Cross for 34 years.

It is unknown when Virginia passed away.

COLLECTION DESCRIPTION

The Virginia Irene Meyers Scrapbook contains a variety of materials documenting her time at Dickinson College from 1928 to 1932. Included are coursework and grades, academic awards, Dickinson memorabilia, campus event programs, Pan-Hellenic rushing information, personal letters and cards, notices from the College, and personal drawings. Other artifacts have also been included: a small wooden spoon, pressed flowers, hair clippings, and pins.
