Fredricks County to wit

Joseph W. Lawrence and Allen Talbot
late of Fredricks County yeomen were attached to
answer unto Victoire Pauline Marie Gabrielle
De La Vincendiere in a plea of Trespass on the ~~and~~ case
and so forth - And when upon the said Victoire by
Roger Brooke Toney her attorney complains that whereas
the aforesaid Joseph and Allen on the eighteenth day of
June in the year eighteen hundred and five at the
County aforesaid was indebted unto the Victoire in the
Sum of one hundred and twenty nine Dollars current
Money for sundry matters and articles properly charged
in account as by a particular account thereof herewith
into Court exhibited may appear, and being so thereof
indebted the aforesaid Joseph and Allen, afterwards
that is to say on the same day and year aforesaid
at the County aforesaid, in consideration thereof upon
themselves opened and to the said Victoire then and
there faithfully promised, to pay her the said Sum of
money when afterwards they should be thereunto required.

And whereas also the said Joseph and Allen afterwards
that is to say on the same day and year aforesaid at the
County aforesaid accounted together with the aforesaid
Victoire of and concerning divers other sums of money
before that time due and owing from the said Joseph
and Allen to the said Victoire, and then and there
being in arrear and unpaid, and upon that account
the said Joseph and Allen, were then and there found
in arrear and indebted to the said Victoire in another
Sum of one hundred and twenty nine Dollars current money
and being so found in arrear and indebted the aforesaid
Joseph and Allen in consideration thereof, afterwards
that is to say on the same day and year ^{last} aforesaid at
the County aforesaid under taken and to the said Victoire
then and there faithfully promised to pay her the said
last mentioned Sum of current money when afterwards
they should be thereunto required - Nevertheless the
said Joseph and Allen tho' after thereunto afterwards

requested, that is to say on the same day and year
 aforesaid and after afterwards at the County, have
 not yet paid to the said Victoire the said several
 sums of money or either of them or any part of them
 or of either of them, but to pay the same or any part
 thereof they the said Joseph and Allen have hitherto
 have hitherto altogether refused and still do refuse
 to pay the same to the said Victoire - To the damage
 of the said Victoire in the sum of three hundred
 Dollars current money and therefore she brings
 Suit And do for the
