Frederick County to wit

John Belashmuth late of Frederick County your
was attached to answer George Jacob Schley in a
plea of trespass on the case under fault and whereupon
the said George by R. B. Toney his attorney ^{complainant} ~~fault~~
that whereas the said John on the twenty eighth day
of September in the year eighteen hundred at Frederick
County aforesaid was indebted to the said George in
the sum of thirty three pounds eleven shillings and
~~ten~~ ^{ten} pence ^{half penny} current money for meat, drink, washing
lodging ^{mending} and other necessaries by the said George for the
said John at his special instance and request, before
that time found and provided for a long time to wit
from the fourth day of November ^{in the year} ~~eighteen hundred~~
seventeen hundred and ninety nine to the twenty
seventh day of September in the year eighteen hundred
to wit at the County aforesaid
and being so indebted the said John in consideration
thereof afterwards that is to say on the same day and
year ^{first} aforesaid at Frederick County aforesaid, undertook
and then and there faithfully promised the said George
to pay him the said sum of thirty three pounds eleven
shillings and ten pence ^{half penny} current money
whenever afterwards he the said John should be
thereunto requested - And whereas also afterwards that
is to say the same day and year ^{first} aforesaid at the
County aforesaid in consideration that the said George
had before that time at the like special instance and
request of the said John found and provided for the said
John other sufficient meat drink washing lodging
mending and other necessaries for a long time to wit

from the fourth day of November in the year Seventeen
hundred and ninety nine to the twenty seventh day of
September in the year eighteen hundred at the county
aforesaid, the said John undertook and faithfully
promised the said George that he the said John would
well and truly pay to the said George so much current
money as he therefor reasonably deserved to have of the
said George for such meat drink washing lodging
mending and other necessaries so found and provided
by the said George for the said John as aforesaid that
is to say at the county aforesaid - and the said George
in fact faith that he therefor reasonably deserved to
have of the said John for the said meat drink washing
lodging mending and other necessaries so found and
provided for the said John as aforesaid another
sum of thirty three pounds eleven shillings and two
pence half penny current money of which the said John
afterwards that is to say the same day and year ^{first} aforesaid
at the county aforesaid had notice - Nevertheless the said John the ^{first} after
afterwards requested by the said George that is to say on the
same day and year ^{first} aforesaid and after afterwards
at the county aforesaid hath not yet paid the
said several sums of money or either of them or
any part of them or either of them to the said George
but to pay the same or any part thereof to the
said George the said John hath hitherto wholly
refused and still doth refuse to pay the same to the
said George to the damage of the said George in
the sum of one hundred pounds current money
and therefore he brings his suit and go forth
