Jennings of bold of your Regt & also from Rient Harvey Je Reakest Regt In Master to induce you to give your Con - Sent to their being mustered into Service in their respective positions, thus sellings Commissions in your Olegt. Ind that a Citizen Mr. Charles Mayne of Phila a was violently Threatened & assaulted by Certain men of your Command who were incited by your personal presence & aders; Mr. Hayne being at that time on a bisit to Certain Officers in your Camp & this without any provocation on the part of Mr league & in brotation of the 32" \$ 332 of the articles of lar for the government of

the armies of the United States. 300 Shat on accounts for dransportation & Subsistence for recruits for your Regt presented & paid by me, one account in the name of Ed Misbahan for \$ 59 500 & another account in the name of Henry 6. Sanford for \$ 8 you falsely swore to the Correctness of said accounts & received the money paid in same well knowing that the said accounts were incorrect & fraudulent, Up Obdt Devot Call buff bot Um Frishmutte 12th Cavaly Papols Philada Da Sunto 3: Carly MAnny musteringOfficer
