Richmond Va

June 13th 1857

My dear Sir. I have just returned from the Mountains and after travelling all night write barely to acknowledge yours of 2th - I hope you will deal hardly by the Soft and expose their Con-nexion at Cincinnati in 1856 with the fire-eater, Mr. Hunt's nephew proposed to the Pa. Delegation to give them the whole vote of N.Y. It was to have been cast for Hunt. - But, as you say, you know what you are about. Play the play out & have your fun. I did not visit the Post. - He was at Balt: when I reached Washington and I did not see him on his re-turn. You see he avoided

Richmond, going Home,
in his travels to & from
N. Carolina. - You
may well be satisfied
he is no candidate,
and that he can't make
one of a Bobb!

The result in Virginia
is undoubtedly now
a crushing out of Kenton
& his whole Closet-crew.

If you can come
to see me, I shall
be most happy to
receive you. I fear
no injury from any
cause of that sort. So
come in welcome.
