FREDERICK COUNTY, to wit:

Joseph Howard late of Frederick County,
yeoman

was summoned to answer unto *John Clemson*

in a plea that he render unto him the sum of *Forty four Dollars*
current money, which he owes to and unjustly detains from him and so forth.

And whereupon the said *John*
by Roger Brooke Taney his attorney, saith, that whereas the aforesaid *Joseph*

on the *eighteenth* day of *February* in the year of our Lord, eighteen
hundred and *Eight* at Frederick county aforesaid by his certain bill obligatory

Five Months after the date thereof promised
to pay to the said John on order the
Said Sum of forty four Dollars with
legal interest after due for value
received

Nevertheless the aforesaid *Joseph*
(although often thereunto afterwards requested, to wit, at the county aforesaid) the afore-
said sum of money, or any part thereof, to the said *John*

hath not rendered or paid, but the same or any part thereof to the said *John*

to render or pay the said *Joseph*

hath hitherto altogether refused, and still doth refuse. Wherefore the said *John*

saith he is injured and hath damage to the value of *Thirty Dollars*
current money, and therefore he brings suit, and so forth. And the said *John*

brings into Court here the bill obligatory
aforesaid, sealed with the seal of the said *Joseph*
which testifies the debt aforesaid in form aforesaid, the date whereof is the day and year
aforesaid, and so forth.
