I spoke to Captain
Buller on the subject of which
we conversed the last time I saw
you. he tells me that the Pay of
the Officers was settled to the 16th
April 1781. from that time until
Sept: 3^d. 1781: we must charge the
United States with my Father's
Pay as a Brigadier Genl. and with
Rations & Forage from the Time
of his Appointment which was
March 1st. 1776. There are some
Credits to be given but what they
are we can not tell and our
Acc^t. must be rendered to pre-
sent

vent a total Occlusion - The Memo-
rial I trust you will offer to con-
sider if nothing is already done.

If a Purchaser should offer for
the Plantation in my Absence
We must take £6. per Acre if
no more can be got, as I
think the sooner we can raise
Money to discharge the Debts
the greater the Advantage will
be to the Estate. I wish you a
very pleasant Journey and am
