I, once more, am in need of

me, if possible. — On last December 1855. Messrs. Simon

Chadron & Co. merchants Philadelphia, have on my
account, in the wagon of John M. Conahy, sundry

losing one Box and one Trunk, amounting to 1800 Dollars.

I beg you to have the same advertised, in the papers of

Carbide, but please to do it, to an act kind, my pursuing

the man, against whom I have a suit at this court. The

your Town and Chap's his head at Pittsburgh: at

last, it is to be presumed.
