Sir -

Mr Cooper gave me a list of 5 tracts of  
lands, belonging to you in Catawissa, which you propos'd  
to exchange for my Brick house in North - Unless I  
have the drafts of the land with the waters laid <sup>down</sup> & the  
adjoining tracts marked, it will be impossible for me  
to find them. I rather suspect from their being situat-  
ed in Catawissa they are mountains, unless you  
know the contrary to be the case it will not be worth  
while taking any further trouble about them
