DIGNITY is a community of gay Catholics and their friends who believe that God made and loves us all and that we have a right to full membership in the faith community, including the right to share in the spiritual and sacramental life of the Church.

Founded in 1969, DIGNITY became a national organization in 1973. Presently there are over seventy chapters throughout the United States and Canada.

DIGNITY/CENTRAL PENNSYLVANIA was established in 1975. Our membership is open to women and men of all faiths who share the ideals of DIGNITY.

DIGNITY/CENTRAL PENNSYLVANIA is incorporated as a non-profit organization in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and receives no financial support from the Catholic Church or from any agency. Its entire operation is made possible through the contributions of its members and by friends who share in the mission and goals of DIGNITY. All contributions are tax-deductible.

## What Is The Purpose Of Dignity?

The purpose of DIGNITY is to promote the cause of the gay community. To do this, we believe that we must accept responsibility:

- **To the Church.** To work for the development of its theology of sexuality and for the acceptance of gay women and men as full and equal members of the one Christ.
- **To society.** To work for justice and social acceptance through education and legal reform.
- **To individual gay persons.** To reinforce their sense of dignity and their self-acceptance and to aid them in becoming more active members of church and society.

DIGNITY is organized to minister to the needs of all gay people, to develop leadership among them and to be an instrument through which the gay Catholic may be heard in the church and the world.
