The first 3 years we circulated for free, sponsored by benefits and the generosity of all of you. Since then, mailing and production costs have gone up dramatically. As we add up our expenses and look to expanding, we see a need to raise our yearly subscription rate to \$10. We hope that you continue your support of the Lavender Letter and the community it serves. 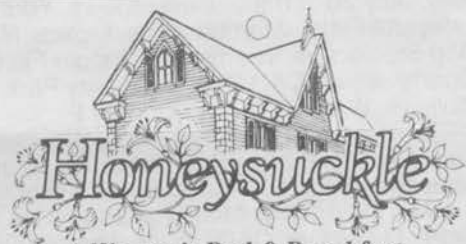
