There are numerous semen banks in the United States, including the Hershey Medical Center. However, there is a great difference among the banks with regard to their screening, record keeping, counseling and educational services, etc. It is imperative that you protect yourself and your unborn child by carefully investigating these services. One organization which has a particularly good reputation is The Sperm Bank of Northern California in the Oakland/Berkeley area. BUT - Before you do anything else, read this excellent book: "Considering Parenthood: A Workbook For Lesbians", by Cheri Pies. It is available for \$9.50 at Giovanni's Room, Philadelphia.
