



ORGANIZATIONAL HISTORY

1980: Lily & Company is formed.

1985-1988: February and August drag shows are performed at the Stallions. All tipe collected are donated to the South Central AIDS Assistance Network (SCAAN).

1988: The Third Street Players, an acting arm of Lily & Company, perform Larry Kramer's play The Normal Heart at the Rose Lehrman Arts Center on the HACC campus. Proceeds go to SCAAN.

1989: An annual August show—Foreign Affairs—is performed at the Holiday Inn Town for the first time with over \$3,000 going to SCAAN. The show is repeated at Altland's Ranch in York with proceeds given to GUSH—York's AIDS organization.

A Board of Directors is established and By-Laws are adopted the following year. The organization is formally known as Lily White & Company. Lily becomes incorporated in 1992.

1990: The Lily Patient Relief Fund (LPRF) for AIDS organizations is formally established. Lily's Community Fund for gay and lesbian groups, as well as the Lily Light Fund for equipment purchases, are established in 1992.

1991: Regular cabarets begin at the Paper Moon restaurant in October with tips collected and earmaked for SCAAN. Regular Strawberry Café shows begin in July 1993 to raise funds for company productions so more money can be donated to organizations.

Lily travels to Lancaster's Days Inn hotel to help raise funds for Eagles' Wing Hospice.

The first run of the Lily production Loose in Paradise is performed at Illusions raising more funds for the LPRF.





1992: Leather and Lamé is performed at Club Raje in conjunction with the Pennamen's Run (tips collected go to the LPRF).

The debut of Lily's Something Old, Someone New takes place at The D-GEM. The show is repeated at The Paper Moon.

The second hotel show at The Harrisburg Hotel (formerly Holiday Inn Town) opens. Hystery of the World According to Lily raises over \$10,000 for SCAAN, Hospice of Central Pennsylvania and York House Hospice. The show is later performed at York's Mackley's Mill raising additional funds for York House Hospice.

1993: Something Old, Someone New II is performed for The Pennemen (at The Quality Inn Riverfront) and Parente and Friende of Leebiane and Gaye (PFLAG) (at The Harrieburg Hotel) with performer's tipe going to the LPRF. The show is repeated at The Paper Moon with over \$1,000 in tipe going to The Gay & Leebian Switchboard of Harrieburg.

Lily White and Company, Inc. stages its second dramatic work—Terrence McNally's The Lisbon Traviata—at Open Stage of Harrisburg. Over \$3,000 is donated to York House Hospice.

Lily performe ite firet lipeynch mueical as **Broadway Angel** is held for four performances at The Paper Moon. Tipe are donated to SCAAN through the LPRF.

**1994**: Lily resurrects Loose in Paradise as a dinner/theater show and performs it in the newly-established Strawberry Coach House. The three shows raise over \$1,200 in tips for the LPRF. The show is repeated at Bridgeside Square in Downtown Harrisburg raising more tips bringing Lily's total benevolence to over \$40,000!

Lily performs with the Harrisburg Men's Chorus' annual Spring Concert in May.




