


From Philadelphia: NE Extention of the Turnpike to I-80. Take Exit 53, Delaware Water Gap.

Due to the difficulties of maintaining a committee with participants from all over the state and the uncertain participation of various members, we have discovered that a very important detail of the Pride '78 Conference was missed before now. We ask your cooperation, please, in correcting it.

Enclosed is a self-adressed postcard which seeks your return of the following information:

The name of your organization, the year founded, and the name(s) of the persons who are credited with being the original founders of it. As you know, Pride '78 scheduled a banquet described as a ounder's Dinner It is the intention of the Committee at this dinner to honor a small portion of the unsung heroes of the Pennsylvania Movement, notably those who parented the organizations, litally without whom there would be no gay liberation in Pennsylvania. Please, in replying, circle the names of Founders who will be known to be attending the banquet. Dear friend and pre-registered person,

We need to take the extraordinary step of consulting with you about the cancellation of Pride '78 on January 20th. First, we hope the cancellation meant no undue inconvenience or concern to you. We tried, and we believe we succeeded in contacting each of you about the cancellation on Friday afternoon. Not all of you, however, were informed that the conference had been rescheduled for April 7-8-9 at the same site.

We will reconvene with the same speakers and workshop staff. We pledge, however, that a great deal more will be added to the April conference which could not be included in January. In short, we plan to take good advantage of the time left in improving our plans.

Enclosed please find a postcard for you to indicate whether you wish a refund of the the monies you have committed to Pride '78, or whether you wish to remain pre-registered for April. Please return the enclosed card at once.

A few announcements are in order. The new flyer for April will contain a lot of information not included on the first one. While you need not register with it again, we know you will be interested in obtaining a copy of it. All registrations after January 10th (as previously announced) will be \$15, and \$17 at the door. Room rates will remain the same at \$13 per person per night, except that we can no longer honor requests for single rooms. Accommodations provide for doubles and qauruples.
