PRIDE '79 is the annual Pennsylvania Lesbian/Gay conference. (There have been three others - in 1972, 1975 and last year's PRIDE '78) The theme this year is "Our Space For Growth." PRIDE '79 will provide a time to share ideas and talents, to learn about ourselves and others, and to increase our strength as a community. The movement for Lesbian/Gay rights in Pennsylvania is entering its third decade, and while we have achieved much in the past twenty years, the next ten will be crucial to our eventual success. Working together we can all grow. We hope you will be able to join us.

PRIDE '79 promises to be a very active weekend, as the schedule at the right shows. The conference will be held at the Pittsburgh Airport Holiday Inn, in Coraopolis, Pa. (about 45 minutes from downtown Pittsburgh.)

PRIDE '79 is sponsored by the Pennsylvania Lesbian/ Gay Support Network with help from groups and individuals all over the state. REGISTRATION FEES

The General Conference Admission is \$15, before October 10th, and \$17 afterwards and at the door. (Checks received after Oct. 10 will be returned.) General Admission includes all meetings and workshops; Saturday evening banquet; entertainment and disco dance (cash bar).

Partial fees: If you wish to attend only selected events, the fees are: \$5 for meetings and workshops; \$10 for Saturday banquet; \$5 for entertainment and dance (\$7.50 at the door).

ACCOMMODATIONS

All rooms at the Holiday Inn are equipped with the usual amenities: bath, TV, heat/air conditioning. The hotel also has a pool. ROOM RESERVATIONS will be made at the same time as you register for the conference. PAYMENT FOR ROOMS goes directly to the Holiday Inn. If paying by check, they will need two pieces of identification. Accepted credit cards are: Diners Club, American Express, VISA, Mastercharge and Gulf Travel.

There will be limited housing spaces available outside the conference site, in Pittsburgh. It will be about a 45 minute drive from this housing to the conference. Priority will be given to the first people to sign up and to those who have to travel the longest distances.

RELIGIOUS SERVICES

Space has been set aside for those who want to participate in Lesbian/Gay worship services. Though unconfirmed as of publication date, there will probably be a Jewish service on Saturday, and services conducted by MCC, Dignity, and the Friends (Quakers) on Sunday. Other religious groups wishing to hold services should notify the PRIDE '79 planning committee at: PO Box 4031 Allentown, Pa. 18105, in order to reserve space.

TRAVEL INFORMATION

BY AIR: Most major cities have regular air service to Pittsburgh. Call your local airlines for info.

BY BUS: There is bus service from many Pa. cities. Call for schedule and fares.

BY TRAIN: There are trains from eastern Pa. — Allentown, Philadelphia & Lancaster — via Harrisburg & Johnstown to Pittsburgh. Call AMTRAK for information.

FROM BUS & TRAIN STATION IN PITTSBURGH

Walk to William Penn or Hilton Hotels (about 2 blocks) and take Airport Shuttle Bus (\$3.50). At the airport, call the Holiday Inn on their courtesy phone and they will send a van for you.

NOTE: The shuttle does not operate between 10PM and 5AM. If arriving between those hours, check the appropriate box on the registration form, to arrange alternate transportation.

BY CAR (Many organizations will be arranging car pools, call your local groups or switchboard for information.)

FROM PHILADELPHIA AREA: Take Pa. Turn-pike, west to exit 6. Follow directions below)

FROM ALLENTOWN/EASTON AREA: Take Interstate 78 & 81 to Pa. Turnpike at Harrisburg, interchange 16; then take Turnpike west to exit 6. OR: Take Interstate 80 west to Interstate 79, follow directions for Erie.

FROM SCRANTON/WILKES-BARRE: Take I - 80 west to Interstate 79, follow directions for Erie.

FROM WILLIAMSPORT/STATE COLLEGE: Take US 220 to US 22 (near Altoona), Follow 22 west to Interstate 376 (near exit 6 of Turnpike), Follow directions below.

FROM HARRISBURG/SOUTHERN PA: Take Pa. Turnpike west to exit 6. (Follow directions below)

FROM ERIE/NORTHEAST PA: Take Interstate 79, south to Interstate 279. Follow signs to airport, bear right immediately past the airport, Holiday Inn is approximately ½ mile on the left.

FROM EXIT 6 ON TURNPIKE: Take Interstate 376 & 279 (Parkway). Follow signs to airport. Bear right immediatley past the Greater Pittsburgh Airport. Holiday Inn is approximately ½ mile on the left.
