PRIDE '80 will provide a time to share ideas and talents, to learn about ourselves and others, and to increase our strength as a community. The movement for Lesbian/Gay rights in Pennsylvania is now in its third decade, and while much has been achieved, the next ten years will be crucial to our eventual success. PRIDE '80 promises to be a very active weekend, as the schedule at the right shows. Details of these events are still being worked out, and more will likely be added. ACCOMMODATIONS

All rooms at the Holiday Inn are equipped with the usual amenities: bath, TV, heat/air conditioning. The hotel also has a pool. ROOM RESERVATIONS will be made at the same time as you register for the conference. PAYMENT FOR ROOMS goes directly to the Holiday Inn. If paying by check, they will need two pieces of identification.

ROOM CHARGES: (add %6 tax to all charges)

Single: 1 person, 1 bed \$28 a night, per room \$34 a night, per room Double: 3 people, 2 beds Double: 4 people, 2 beds \$40 a night, per room

There will be limited housing spaces available outside the conference site, in the Harrisburg area. Most will be within 20 minutes of the conference. Priority will be given to the first people to sign up and to those who have to travel the longest distances.

RELIGIOUS SERVICES

Space has been set aside for those who want to participate in Lesbian/Gay worship services. Though not all have been confirmed as of publication, there will probably be a Jewish service on Friday evening, and services conducted by MCC, Dignity, and the Friends (Quaker) on Sunday. Other religious groups wishing to hold services should notify the PRIDE '80 planning committee at the address on the registration form in order to reserve space.

COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARDS

Each year the Pennsylvania Lesbian/Gay Support Network presents awards recognizing 'exemplary community service', to individuals and groups who have consistently and selflessly served the Penna. Lesbian/Gay community. The recipients are selected by the executive committee of the Network, from nominations submitted by people from around the state.

TRAVEL INFORMATION

BY AIR: TWA and USAir have regularly scheduled air service to Harrisburg. Call your local airline agent for information.

BY BUS: Greyhound and Trailways have frequent service to Harrisburg from most Pa. cities. Call for schedule and fares.

BY TRAIN: AMTRAK has regular service from Philadelphia, Lancaster and points in between to Harrisburg. There are three trains daily from Pittsburgh to Harrisburg.

BUS AND TRAIN TERMINALS are in the same building, which is just two blocks from the Holiday Inn. If you don't want to walk, there is ample taxi service at the terminal.

BY CAR: (Many organizations will be arranging car pools, call your local groups or switchbaord for information.)

The Holiday Inn is located at 2nd & Chestnut Sts., in Downtown Harrisburg. Second St. is one way, North; Chestnut St. is one way, east. The map below will show you how to get to the conference from the Turnpike, Interstate system (i.e. I 80), and other major highways.
