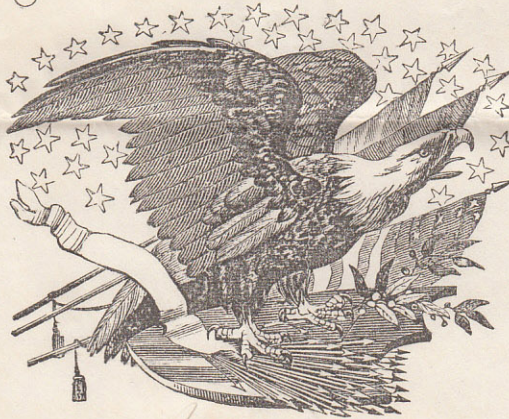

Know ye, That, <sup>1st Lt</sup> John Hays Adjutant a  
of Captain

Company, ( ) 130<sup>th</sup> Regiment of Penna Vols  
VOLUNTEERS who was enrolled on the Fifth day of August  
one thousand eight hundred and sixty two to serve nine months or  
during the war, is hereby Discharged from the service of the United States,  
this Twenty first day of May, 1863, at Camp Curtin  
Harrisburg Pa by reason of Expiration of Enlistment  
(No objection to his being re-enlisted is known to exist.)\*

Said 1st Lt & adj. Jno Hays was born in Carlisle Penna Pa  
in the State of Pennsylvania, is 26 years of age,  
5 feet 8 inches high, Light complexion, Blue eyes,  
Dark hair, and by occupation, when enrolled, a Lawyer

Given at Camp Curtin this Twenty first day of  
May 1863.
