

What do student workers do in the Dickinson College Archives & Special Collections?

Organize

- physical photographs (such as prints, negatives, and slides)
- college records (such as documents from academic depts., athletics, student organizations, and college committees)
- personal papers (such as diaries, letters, and scrapbooks)

Transcribe

- oral history interviews for LGBT History Project
- handwritten diaries, letters, journals, etc. (in English, French, or Russian)

- Describe, photograph, and store artifacts (such as t-shirts and buttons)
- Create small physical exhibits for display in the library
- Compile information and research on Dickinson College history and Carlisle Indian School topics
- Assist with Carlisle Indian School or LGBT History projects
- Edit digital audio and/or video files
- Reach out to student-run groups, organizations, and activities
