BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

John Perry Wood was born on March 30, 1879 to Rev. John Allen Wood and Ida Perry Wood in Baltimore, MD. Soon after John Perry's birth, he and his family moved to Everett, PA where his father worked as a pastor. It was during this time that J. A. and Ida Wood had five other children: Gilbert, John, Margaret, Earl, and Melvin.

John Perry, or Perry, as his friends and family called him, attended the Dickinson Seminary in Williamsport, PA from 1894 to 1897, and sometime during his tenure at the seminary his family moved from Everett to Tyrone, PA and then to Bellefonte, PA. In 1897 Perry enrolled at Dickinson College to study law and graduated in 1901 with a Bachelor of Arts degree. Perry was a member of the Sigma Alpha Epsilon fraternity, the track team, and the mock trial team during his time at Dickinson.

In 1902, Perry graduated from Yale University with his M.A. and LL.B. He then moved to Pasadena, CA where his grandparents lived. Perry practiced law in a private firm from 1902 to 1906 and then became an attorney for the city of Pasadena in 1906. As a city attorney Perry was instrumental in setting up the municipal water system, successfully fighting the water companies who argued for less regulatory restrictions from the city in a case that nearly went before the U.S. Supreme Court.

In 1910, Perry married Claudette Hazen with whom he had three children: Walbridge, Dana, and Charles M. Wood. In the same year of Perry and Claudette's marriage Perry was elected as a judge of the Los Angeles county Superior Court. He served as presiding judge in 1918 and resigned from his post in 1925. From 1925 until his retirement in the 1950s Perry practiced private law with his firm Wood, Crump, Rogers, and Arndt. He was a member of the Dickinson General Alumni Association, President of the Yale Alumni Association of California, and chairman of the California and American Bar Association during his time in Pasadena. It is

unclear what happened to Claudette, but Perry eventually remarried to Elizabeth Monroe. He died on August 10, 1959 in Pasadena.

Perry's sibling, Gilbert, entered the Dickinson Seminary the same year that Perry entered Dickinson College, 1897. Gilbert graduated from Dickinson Seminary in 1901 and decided to pursue a career in dentistry. He enrolled at the University of Southern California, but transferred to the University of Pennsylvania School of Dental Medicine after just one year. Gilbert was a member of the Glee Club at the University of Pennsylvania and was a very successful student. However, in May of 1905, just weeks before he was planning to graduate, Gilbert Wood came down with a serious case of typhoid fever. He died on May 10, 1905.

In 1906, soon after Gilbert's death, the entire Wood family elected to move from Bellefonte, PA, where they had lived for the last three years, to Pasadena. John Wood, the next oldest sibling after Gilbert, had already moved out to California to work in a bank in Pasadena. Twins Melvin and Earl graduated from Polytechnic High in Pasadena in 1911. After a year-long hunting expedition in Oregon with family friends the two recent graduates moved back to Pasadena where they started a printing press known as "The Twin Printers." Margaret, the youngest sibling and only sister of Perry Wood, went to live with her Uncle Melvin and Aunt Alice for a while in 1916. While she was living in Minneapolis, MN she met Arthur Morse. In December of 1916, Arthur and Margaret Morse were married. Her father, Rev. J. A. Wood, spent the last years of his career preaching at several churches around the Los Angeles/Pasadena area. His wife, Ida Perry Wood, died on March 23, 1925.

COLLECTION DESCRIPTION

The John Perry Wood family papers are arranged into three series: Scrapbooks, Diary, and Photo Album.

The Scrapbooks series is by far the largest and most detailed of the three series. This series contains nine scrapbooks of letters, photos, news clippings, and other miscellaneous pieces of memorabilia ranging from 1896 to 1925. The main subjects and authors of these letters include Rev. John A. Wood; his wife Ida Perry Wood; their sons J. Perry Wood, Gilbert Wood, John Wood, Melvin Wood, and Earl Wood; and their daughter Margaret Wood Morse. Other actors in this collection include Arthur Morse, the eventual husband of Margaret; J. A.'s brother and sister-in-law Melvin and Alice Wood; and the parents of J. A. Wood, addressed as J. A. and "Grandma" Wood. The letters in the scrapbooks are largely the day-to-day activities of one family member being reported to another in a different part of the country. The letters seem to be most concentrated, however, during the major flashpoints of the Wood family timeline, such as marriage, death, and the relocation of family members. The scrapbooks are organized in chronological order. Only Scrapbook Three is bound. The remaining scrapbooks were either never bound or were unbound at some point. The loose contents of those books are arranged roughly chronologically in folders.

- Scrapbook One mainly consists of letters between Perry, Gilbert, J. A., and Ida Wood. During the time period within which these letters were written Perry graduated from Dickinson Seminary in Williamsport, he started Dickinson College in Carlisle, PA, and Gilbert started school at Dickinson Seminary. Perry and Gilbert wrote letters to each other comparing their experiences and offering advice to each other, while J. A. and Ida

Wood's letters generally involve questions and advice to Perry and Gilbert or information/love letters between themselves.

- Scrapbook Two deals almost solely with Perry's senior year at Dickinson College and his year spent at Yale University. It includes letters, programs for school events, and a newspaper clipping. Most letters are to or from Perry, and the subject of these letters is generally Perry's complaints about his longing for family and the difficulty of his work or his parents' or brother's reassurances.
- Scrapbook Three's contents are a memorial for Gilbert Wood, who died in 1905. The scrapbook contains pictures of Gilbert and schools that Gilbert attended, the last letters that Gilbert sent, letters between family members regarding Gilbert's condition during his last days, condolence letters, sermons about death, fabric from Gilbert's last suit, and a lock of Gilbert's hair.
- Scrapbook Four is a continuation of Scrapbook Three. Its contents include letters to and from Gilbert leading up to his death, newspaper articles about Gilbert's achievements and his death, and condolence letters.
- Scrapbook Five is by far the most eclectic scrapbook of the series. It contains letters and clippings from 1906 to 1911. The beginning of the scrapbook has many letters to and from the Wood family regarding their move to Pasadena. The remaining letters include details about the various travels of J. A. and Ida Wood; Perry Wood's law career; and the well-being of Margaret, Earl, and Melvin. This scrapbook also contains the documentation of Earl and Melvin's hunting trip to Oregon in 1911.
- Scrapbook Six contains letters from 1912, 1913, and 1916. The letters from 1912 and 1913 include exchanges between Ida Wood and her children, some clippings about Perry's law career, and other miscellaneous letters. The letters from 1916 deal mainly with the engagement of Margaret Wood to Arthur Morse, including an exchange between Margaret and her parents asking for marriage advice.
- Scrapbook Seven contains a collection of letters between J. A. and Ida Wood and between Ida Wood and her younger children, including Melvin, Margaret, and Earl. There are also miscellaneous letters between various members of the family in 1911 in this scrapbook.
- Scrapbook Eight, the shortest of the scrapbooks, includes a collection of Christmas cards from Christmas 1923 and miscellaneous newspaper clippings and other memorabilia regarding the Wood family.
- Scrapbook Nine deals solely with the death of Ida P. Wood. It includes newspaper obituaries, condolence notes, poems, pictures of Ida Wood, funeral bills, and health records.

The Diary series contains the diary of Martha Wood from the year 1880. Martha documents her day-to-day life around Providence, RI and her travels to Paris, England, the Suez Canal, and India. Segments of self-penned poetry are also inserted at parts throughout the diary. All of the day-to-day activities, travels, and poetry in the diary are tied together by a central theme of Christianity. Most of Martha's activities involve going to revivals and church services, either in the United States or abroad, and counting the number of people "saved" at a given event. The diary also contains various handwritten recipes, scribbled calculations of mortgage payments, and addresses. Martha's relation to the rest of the Wood family documented by the majority of this collection is a bit unclear. The "Mr. Wood" who preaches on her trip appears to be Rev. J. A. Wood, Jr. She also seems to have a relationship with Ida Wood, about whom she writes quite often, and she also mentions Melvin, J. A. Wood's brother.

The Photo Album series includes a photo album containing approximately 40 pages of unlabeled photographs that range from the late 19th century to the late 1940s. The only families mentioned in the album are the Jones and Traweek families, which are named in a newspaper clipping regarding Charlotte Traweek's marriage to Ernest C. Jones. Otherwise, the people photographed remain unknown, and the connection to the Wood family is unclear.
