To the Honorable the Judges of Frederick
County Court -

The Petitioner of the said ~~County~~
Sheweth that a certain Mergent young heath
obtained a judgment against your Petitioner
before Peter Burkhart Esquire a Justice of
the Peace for Frederick County, for the sum of
Seven pounds Six Shillings and three pence
Current money, and four shillings and ten
pence costs - your Petitioner having prayed an
Appeal from the said judgment, now prays your
Honours to take the same into consideration
& to reverse the said judgment with costs
to your Petitioner, because the said said judgment
is upon a claim which never had any foundation
in Law or equity or Justice, and is besides
of more than three years standing -
