Richard Fern late of Frederick County was attached to answer unto John Denn wherefore with force and arms and so forth at Frederick County aforesaid he entered into all that tract or parcel of plantable land called ~~Three hundred and fifty three~~ <sup>Maryland</sup> lying and being in Frederick County aforesaid, containing ~~three hundred and fifty three~~ <sup>three hundred and fifty three and three quarters</sup> acres with the appertinances, which Edward Thomas demised to the said John for a term of years which is not yet expired and ejected him from his said farm; and also wherefore with force and arms and so forth at the County aforesaid he the said Richard entered into fourteen acres of arable land lying and being in the County aforesaid which the said Edward Thomas demised to the said John for a term of years which is not yet expired and ejected him from his said fourteen acres of arable land and other wrongs to the said John there did to the great damage of the said John and against the peace government and dignity of the state and so forth. And whereupon the said John by Roger Brooke Jany his attorney complains that the said Edward Thomas on the first day of January ~~last~~ <sup>in the year eighteen hundred & eight</sup> at Frederick County aforesaid had demised unto the said John all that tract or parcel of plantable land called ~~Three hundred and fifty three~~ <sup>Maryland</sup> lying and being in the County aforesaid containing ~~three hundred and fifty three~~ <sup>three hundred and fifty three and three quarters</sup> acres with the appertinances to have and to hold the same premises with the appertinances <sup>to him</sup> ~~to him~~ and his assigns from the thirty first day of December then last past for and during and unto the full end and term of fifteen years from thence next ensuing and fully to be complete and ended; and also that on the ~~thirtieth~~ <sup>first day of January</sup> ~~of said~~ <sup>eighteen hundred & eight</sup> the said Edward Thomas had demised to the said John all the aforesaid fourteen acres of arable land lying and being in the County aforesaid to have and to hold the same fourteen acres of arable land to him the said John and his assigns from the thirty first day of December then last past for and during and unto the full end and term of fifteen years from thence next ensuing and fully to be complete and ended; by virtue of which said several demises the said John entered into the said several parcels of land and was possessed thereof and being so possessed thereof the said Richard afterwards to wit on the first day of January ~~last~~ <sup>in the year eighteen hundred & eight</sup> aforesaid with force and arms; that is to say with swords staves and knives at the County aforesaid entered into the said several parcels of land which the said Edward had demised to the said John in manner aforesaid for the term aforesaid which is not yet expired and ejected the said John from his said several parcels of land and other wrongs to the said John then and there did to the great injury of the said John and against the peace government and dignity of the state and so forth; wherefore the said John saith he is injured and hath damage to the value of ~~one thousand pounds~~ <sup>current money</sup> and therefore brings suit and so forth.
