Warrington Thursday

I have received the parcel from Griffiths  
and disposed of the contents of it according to your  
directions. I communicated the contents of your letter to  
Mr Aikin: We are ~~afraid~~ by no means willing to  
take any thing dishonourably, but ~~we~~ are afraid  
you will lose the whole by too great delicacy  
in the case — This day Mr Aikin and I go over  
to Wisley. Mr Aikin is very glad to hear of another  
Student for Divinity. The poverty of our numbers doth  
really discourage us all. I am with compliments  
to Mr Liddon &c.
