Pelypont 4 April 1862

Dear Sir

I did not receive your letter of the 28th of March till Saturday. I formed my opinion that the members of the Clearfield C. & S. Co were individually liable for debts contracted in the name of the Co. on the residence of Peter Titus and some papers which were in my hands until a few weeks since. Peter Titus is now in Virginia and I have returned <sup>the papers</sup> to my client whose claim is settled by Mr. Cuy. If it is not too late (as I infer from your letter the trial is over in which you wished to use the information) I will be happy to furnish you with the facts and so pick I formed my opinion. I can hear from Titus in a few days and can get the papers at my pleasure.
