As you must have perceived from the Mississippi papers, I have been conversing the State with Judge Adams for a seat in the U. S. Senate. Our prospects are not only bright for carrying the State by an overwhelming majority, but they are growing brighter every day.

As your paper has an extensive circulation in our State, and as I am an old patriot, I wish you would either transfer the speech to your columns, or at all events give it some notice.
