Monday - June 15th / 03

My dear Mother -

Willie Hawksworth went to
Ams. to see (art. Thursday I believe
I see Amy came to me for yr address
as he wanted to come & see you &
wonder if he has been - I said I would
let you know he was coming -
As I hear you still have 141 letters
to answer I feel sure I shall never
hear again except indirectly - how
are you & do I hear a rumour

that you are going to pay Portishead
a visit this summer - I wonder
what you will think of yr big grandson,
he is a nice boy, but not strong - I do
wish they could have some good part-
for him, the boy hates being idle -
Aren't there little bees pretty?
wonder if you will see any alterations
Nellie has been so good in selling
some work for me - I try my best
as a "P. G." we are not doing well,
but I expect so bad - Shall we see
anything of you - I know you think nothing of
distance - I told the Hawksworths you might
be at Laren. Love, Jessie
