I was received
some time ago. and hoped to
receive a further report about our
blind Indian.

Thinking that the time may come
soon when you will want to return
him I send you my check to
you order for \$50.00 to pay expenses
from Ass. Surgeon's Office for
signature of parties to whom money
is paid. Please have party that
buys his ticket get one signed - and
any lunatic or other expense also.
Having a pleasant winter - schools
full - and Indians comfortable.

Hospital & water system about
complete. Hope to have all
fixes up comfortable for new
occupants after March 4th
