My dear Judge.

I have just received
your letter, & must excuse my
delaying to get to you by forwarding
the mails. I wrote to you imme-
diately upon the receipt of your
letter, but for some reason there
must be a detention in some column, as
it seems to take 3 or 4 days for
your letters to reach me. I am
very sorry that you should feel
anxious, as I promised to keep
you informed of the health of
the family, & really thought I
had fulfilled the promise. I

went in town this morning, &
brought Mother out this afternoon
in the car. She for the trip
very well, & seems pleased with
our home out here. I hope
the country air may prove of
service to her. The children
are very well, & delighted to see
their Grandmother, but George
says, why did not Grandpa Read
come too. We shall all be
glad to see you back again -
I wrote to Betty last week -
