Sydenham, June 14. 1845

My dear Colonel,

I acknowledged by return of
G^t Western, your letters of the 15th and ~~16~~ 19th
of May, and have nothing to add to what I
then said on the subject of a second edition
in London - should there by any possibility be
one - though I do not as yet know for certain
of a first. I also sent the whole remainder
of the printed sheets. The Philadelphia Edition
will be published on the 20th instant. Extracts
from the loose printed sheets, have already found
their way into our newspapers much against
my first wishes; but I had to yield to the
urgency of the publishers.

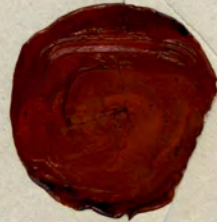
