Erra from the S. C. of
Lancaster distrid to
the 2. sessions of Dauphin

Dear Sir:

I received, on the 27th of last
month, a letter from Mr Elder of Harrisburgh
in which he informs me, that the above
case is on the list for argument on the
third monday in May, and that it
was not certain that Mr Ellmaker would
be at Lancaster at that time. He there-
fore notifies me to attend to it. I have
heard nothing through Mr Ellmaker of the
case, nor have I been apprized of it through
any channel except Mr Elder's letter. My
engagements here, at the period mentioned,
will render it impracticable for me to

leave town, which obliges me to devolve upon
you the trouble of examining into it, and
taking, on my behalf, such steps as you
may be able towards conducting the ar-
gument upon the part of the commorwealth.

I will ask the favor of you to furnish
me with a line upon this subject, and am,
