Dear Sir,

I have found on my table a statement of the defendant's title in the proposed action of Butler & Cadwalader. I believe I have already informed you that I can take no step in the nature of an admission in this case, until I see Major Butler's title; by which I mean that we cannot consent to submit any question upon the defendant's title until we are satisfied that Major Butler's is regularly derived, and is a good one if the defendant's is not. I ought to say at the same time, that after General Cadwalader ^{has} submitted his title to Major Butler, it seems proper that Major Butler should do the same, that the Counsel may be respectively on a footing as to information.
