Savannah 21 Jan'y 1812

My Dear Sir

After very considerable
labour & exertion I obtained yesterday the
Report of Auditor in your favor for
about \$3000. & this day I was enabled
to get the rule absolute for the
foreclosure of Richmond & New planta-
-tion: — in all my practice I
have never as yet witnessed so much
evasion, twisting & turning as by the
Defendant in this case. —

This day four labours cease, as the
Court adjourned after a session of
several weeks in which we have
had no leisure to attend to correspon-
-dents, or in fact to do any thing
but attend on the Court. —
