be able to pay the next note of \$300 - also - Please
learn where the notes are to be found -

Our Catalogue will be out in a few
days, & will show our college is advancing steadily -
Our apparatus was received in good order - is put up in
glass cases - and exceeds our expectations. It was an
admirable purchase - it is indeed excellent -
I have a public meeting here on Thursday evening next
in reference to our College - I wish to have one in Shiloh
next week as our 70th J.P. DeLaben
