My dear friend

Madney 23 August 1793

I have only time to say this will be delivered to you by Mrs Priestly, she only determined on going with her Husband, last night, and I did not know of it till this afternoon, her health is much better and I hope a sea voyage will confirm it. you will find her very amiable, I am sure your kindness will not let her want your advice, or assistance, which every stranger must stand in need of in a new country amongst strangers; and where every thing must be new, and as she will have new friends to make, and is inexperienced in every thing that can be acquired to make her comfortable, if you will be so kind when opportunity offers to introduce ^{her} to some of your friends, I shall esteem it as a favour, she has not time to be served with her your recommendation to one will be doing her a great favour. I will not apologise for this Liberty as I am so well acquainted with your humanity and readiness to serve those who stand in need of your kindness

We have often thought of you in your present ^{situation} and hoped you were beyond the reach of the heavy storm on the 17 of this month. may you my dear friend meet all your amiable family well, and happy. I shall hope to hear from you by the very first opportunity after your arrival, and let me hear how all your dear flock received you, I should have been pleased to have

been a witness to such heart felt pleasure as you
must have experienced to have embraced your
children whom you have had so good an account
of in your absence They to be kindly remembered
to all inquiring friends and forgive this hasty
scrawl which will I hope impress you with the
sentiment that I am with truth
