Buchanan 1859 Oct. 24 CURTIN, ANDREW GREGG To John V. Hart. Dear Sir I was from home and your letter of the 14th remains unanswered. Your letter of the 1st July of which you speak did not reach me. Beckwith sold timber for bridges and cross ties to the Tyrone and Lock Haven Rail Road Co on which he was to receive the money in the spring. Then I hoped to lay my hand on the money. The Company has failed to pay. The President of the Company is now in N. York negotiating for the sale of lands. He expects to be successful and if so B - will be in funds.
