Dear Sir

I was gone home and
your letter of the 14th Oct remains unopened
Your letter of the 10th July of which you
think did not reach me -

Beckwith sold timber for six days
and cut ties to the farm and took
down some road for on which he
was to receive the money in the Spring
Now I hoped to buy my land on
the money - The Company has failed
to pay - The President of the Com-
pany is now in N York negotiating for the
sale of bonds - He expects to be successful
and if so B will be in funds -

At all events the claim
must be cleared -

I will be in Phila the
latter end of this month and will
try to see you -

Dear Sir

I was from home and your letter of the 14th remains unanswered. Your letter of the 1st July of which you speak did not reach me.

Beckwith sold timber for bridges and cross ties to the Tyrone and Lock Haven Rail Road Co on which he was to receive the money in the spring. Then I hoped to lay my hand on the money. The Company has failed to pay. The President of the Company is now in N. York negotiating for the sale of lands. He expects to be successful and if so B - will be in funds.
