The two first are perhaps the only ones that are of consequence - this number I have not attended to.

As I find I have too few copies for my friends, who are out of the Society, I hope you will excuse my liberty in requesting that you would favour me with the copy I desired you to keep for yourself. Perhaps also Mr. Cavendish would favour me with his when he has read it. But if you think he would take it amiss, I would not have you it to him. Mr. Johnson will convey them to me.

I am busy in my experiments, and I never remember that a greater number of new facts occurred to me in the same space of time, as since my return from London. At present I have no theory at all for them, and I want a stronger burning lens to prosecute some of them.

One of my present experiments is to prove the production of phlogisticated air from Spirit of Niter and phlogiston, and another that of fixed air from dephlogisticated air and inflammable so that both Mr. Cavendish and Mr. Kirwan may avail themselves of them.
