Dear Sir

I am sorry that you have had the
trouble to write to me, and I thought I had
told you, that I wished to have fifty copies
of my paper printed separately. Please,
however, to get me that number printed,
and stitched in blue paper; and, giving
one copy, with my compliments, to Mr
Cavendish, deliver the rest to Mr Johnson
No 72 St Paul's.

The Society upon diploma I ^{have} received,
is ^{an associat libry} titled La Société Royale de Physique, d'His-
toire naturelle, et des arts, D'Orléans. You
will annex it to my name in the list of the

Society, or not, as you think proper. As it
appears that I really was chosen of the Society
at Stockholm, I think it will certainly be
proper to continue that title; and I have
that an apology will be made for my not
noticing it before.

The second of these papers will be sent
abroad, and to members of the Society, perhaps
it will be right to annex the title to my
name in the title page. I know no good end
that foreign titles answer but I would do what
will be thought right, and I leave the cere-
monial to you. Please to take a care for yourself.
