By the return of Mr. Brown from Savannah I was honored with your Excellency's Letter dated the tenth March last, and it is my Duty to acknowledge the good Effects of your favorable Attention to the Plan with which that young Gentleman was charged on behalf of the United States, it is true he did not succeed to the extent of the Object, but as he got safe back the expedition was of some service.
