PAY to *Henry Martin* Captain of the *Navy* of the Pennsylvania Line, or his order, the sum of *thirty seven pounds eighteen shillings & two pence* being one year's interest on his depreciation certificate, due the tenth day of April 1783, agreeably to an act of The General Assembly, intituled, "An act to appropriate certain monies arising from the excise, for the payment of the annual interest due on unalienated certificates therein mentioned," passed the twenty first day of March last, and out of the fund appropriated by the said act, for the purposes therein mentioned.
