the Eleventh of the Pennsylvania Line, or his order,
the sum of *three pounds twelve shillings and eight pence*
being one year's interest on his depreciation certificate, due the tenth
day of April 1782 agreeably to an act of The General Assembly, in-
titled, "An act to appropriate certain monies arising from the excise, for
"the payment of the annual interest due on unalienated certificates therein
"mentioned," passed the twenty-first day of March 1783, and out of
the fund appropriated by the said act, for the purposes therein men-
tioned.
