I am informed this morning by
the Treasurer that the money in the Branch
at New York is all drawn out except
twenty thousand dollars - Identifying
the draft for \$500,000 which is held by
the Mechanics Bank. - Your Bankers
must therefore be prepared immediately
to meet the Government drafts. - The
draft for \$500,000 had best be returned
as it seems useless to use it when you
will be immediately called on for
the money again. But I must never
draw immediately on the State Bank

As I cannot draw further on the Branch
while that draft is outstanding -

You will therefore be ready at all
times to meet the public ^{warrants &} drafts, and
will communicate this letter to the other
selected
Members.
