I have the Honour to inform you that the United States Corvette John Adams, Captain Wadsworth, has just been despatched to the Havanna, for the purpose of procuring the Release of such Citizens of the United States, including Captain Asa Hosmer, as may be detained there as Prisoners; and that Captain Wadsworth is instructed to bring Home all whose release is effected.
